Venetian Blind Care Routine



A) Weekly Dusting (5–10 minutes)

- 1. Prep the area Place a towel on the sill/floor to catch dust.
- 2. Close & support Close the slats and support each one from underneath.
- 3. Wipe horizontally Use a microfibre cloth/glove from centre to ends.
- 4. Flip and repeat Tilt slats the other way and wipe again.
- 5. Vacuum (optional) Use a soft brush attachment on low suction.
- 6. Final pass Open and close tilt once to remove loose dust.

B) Spot Cleaning (Marks & Fingerprints)

- 1. Mix solution Warm water + a drop of mild dish soap.
 - a. Aluminium/Faux Wood: Use 1:1 water-vinegar for grease.
 - b. Wood: Barely damp cloth with plain water only.
- 2. Support & dab Support slat and gently dab mark.
- 3. Dry immediately Use a clean, dry microfibre cloth.

C) Deep Cleaning (Monthly/Seasonal)

Aluminium & Faux Wood

- 1. Close slats & lay a towel on the sill.
- 2. Use damp (not wet) cloth with mild soapy water.
- 3. Support & wipe each slat horizontally.
- 4. Use vinegar mix for stubborn spots.
- 5. Flip & repeat on reverse side.
- 6. Dry immediately.

Real Wood

- 1. Dust thoroughly first.
- 2. Lightly dampen cloth with plain water or wood-safe cleaner.
- 3. Support & wipe gently, horizontally.
- 4. Avoid vinegar or soaking.
- 5. Dry immediately after each pass.

Pro Tip: Wipe slats with a dryer sheet after cleaning to repel dust.
